For three days around Valentines Day we sent out quartets to give Singing Valentines. One such quartet with a recipient is pictured below.



NEW JERSEY AIR NATIONAL GUARD 177TH FIGHTER WING



The 177th Fighter Wing, located at Atlantic City International Airport, in Egg Harbor Township, NJ, is an operational F-16 Wing, with a worldwide federal mission, and a stateside domestic mission. The 177th₃s mission aircraft is the single seat F-16C Fighting Falcon. Since October 1998, the 177th has had an active involvement in Operation's Noble Eagle, Southern Watch, Northern Watch, Iraqi Freedom and Enduring Freedom. The Wing has 22 F-16 aircraft and 1150 Airmen.



The Pine Barons competed with other choruses at Division level in May, then ascended to District level in October. At Division we finished fourth out of 12 competing choruses, becoming Plateau AAA champions, as shown on the following score sheet.


